1 Name of regulation

This regulation is the Superannuation Industry (Supervision) Amendment Regulation 2012 (No. 4).

2 Commencement

This regulation commences on the day after it is registered.

3 Amendment of Superannuation Industry (Supervision) Regulations 1994

Schedule 1 amends the Superannuation Industry (Supervision) Regulations 1994.

Schedule 1 Amendment

(section 3)

[1] Paragraph 1.03A (1) (a)

substitute

- (a) the member is uncontactable, that is, if and only if:
 - (i) either:
 - (A) the fund has never had an address for the member; or
 - (B) 2 written communications have been sent, or, if the trustee so chooses, one written communication has been sent, by the fund to the member's last known address and returned unclaimed; and
 - (ii) the fund has not received a contribution or rollover in respect of the member within the last 12 months of the member's membership of the fund; or
