1 Paragraph 4.22B(1C)(b)

Repeal the paragraph, substitute:

- (b) in a case where paragraph (1B)(b) applies:
 - (i) the person is employed; and
 - (ii) the person is unable to meet his or her immediate living expenses; or

2 Paragraph 6.19B(1C)(b)

Repeal the paragraph, substitute:

- (b) in a case where paragraph (1B)(b) applies:
 - (i) the person is employed; and
 - (ii) the person is unable to meet his or her immediate living expenses; or
