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What factors should be taken into account in determining whether a medical aid or appliance is specifically designed for people with an illness or disability?

In determining whether a medical aid and appliance is specifically designed for people with an illness or disability reference should be made to the designer's/manufacture's intention of how the good is to be used and its features. Indicators of the designer's/manufacture's intention of how a good is to be used include how the good is marketed and the type of retail outlets at which the goods can be purchased.
